

Berwick gazebo unveiling on Sun.

BERWICK — After about two years of planning, fundraising and hard work, the McIntosh Park Committee will officially unveil its new gazebo with a Family Day at the park in Berwick this Sunday, June 27.

The highlight of the day will be the official opening and ribbon-cutting for the gazebo, which now features two signs to recognize the more than 40 area families who have had trees planted to commemorate loved ones, as well as the businesses and organizations who helped make the park and gazebo a reality.

Taking place shortly after noon, the ceremony will feature representatives from groups and organizations involved in the development of the 4-acre park. Barbecued hamburgers and hotdogs, along with beverages, ice cream and cake will be available afterward. The afternoon will include tree planting and games for the children, and folk, country and bluegrass music from Rev and the Choir Boys. Admission is free, but donations will be gratefully accepted.
