

## SNC hunting season

Hunting in the community forests and other properties under regional conservation control is becoming more popular. The South Nation Conservation Authority (SNC) has noted a 60 per cent increase in the number of permission letters granted for hunting permits on SNC land. The SNC has control over 10,000 acres of land in the South Nation River watershed

in the form of community forests, recreation sites, parklands, and other properties through either outright ownership as a result of purchases, land exchanges, or benefactor bequests, or through management partnership agreements with others. Hunters must have a permission letter from the SNC to hunt in these areas. **The South Nation Conservation Authority (SNC) received confirmation of Environment Canada funding for two of its long-running stewardship projects.**

The SNC will receive \$10,000 for its American ginseng project and \$15,000 for its rare turtles study program. Another \$20,000 will help with mapping needs for other SNC watershed restoration projects.
