

Two Creeks tribute

South Nation Conservation (SNC)'s latest environmental grounds, Two Creeks Trail, is located on County Road 2 west of Morrisburg.

The land, previously owned by Domtar, was at one time a walking trail with regular use, but in recent years had fallen into a state of disrepair.

However, the green space was designated for protection by the Ontario Heritage Trust in 2009, and has been in the possession of the SNC since that time. (At that time, two properties in the Finch area, and the Newington Bog also received protection notice.)

With a rebirth planned, Byvelts is hoping to add a local name to one of the system's walking paths.

Iroquois resident Don Graham was an architect behind the area's revival, and the mayor said it would be fitting if he were recognized in this way.

"This is not precedent-setting, because it's been done before," Byvelts said. "It's an opportunity for us to recognize someone now, and make sure he enjoys [the trail]."

A final decision regarding the naming will be made at the SNC's board level.
