### Position Summary:

SNC requires a highly-motivated individual to undertake ecological surveys. This individual will assist with field work using standardized protocols, sampling and identifying fauna and flora and other related activities. Responsibilities will include the development, maintenance and update of databases, technical reports, funding applications, public relations and committees. This individual will work as part of the lands management team. Familiarity with non-timber forest values and First Nation cultural values are definite assets

### Requirements:

- Enrolment in post secondary education in environmental field, with knowledge of flora and fauna, and ecological restoration.
- Comfortable speaking in public / peer group settings.
- Relate well to both team-oriented and independent situations.
- Demonstrated abilities in aquatic and terrestrial ecosystem classification systems
- Terrestrial and aquatic vegetation identification skills preferred.
- Map reading skills and familiarity with the use of aerial photography.
- GIS and database management experience preferred.
- Valid Ontario driver's license.

- Perform field evaluations, and habitat inventories according to standardized protocols.
- Keep accurate field notes, meeting minutes, budgetary items and prepare technical reports, summary reports and databases within timelines, as required.
