### Do you know where the unused wells are on your property ?

Unsealed, abandoned water wells may pose a hazard to public health and safety. These wells may also affect the wells that we currently use for our drinking water. Sealing of these wells can prevent or eliminate a number of problems including contamination and safety hazards caused by deteriorating well covers.

Large numbers of unused wells exist and have been deteriorating over the years since they were last used as a water supply. Dug wells are of particular concern since fatalities have resulted from their presence in recent years.

Come out to this information session and find out more about locating these wells, what to do to make them safe, and available grant programs. Protect yourself, your family and your neighbours one well at a time.
