Other topics being presented at the conference include:

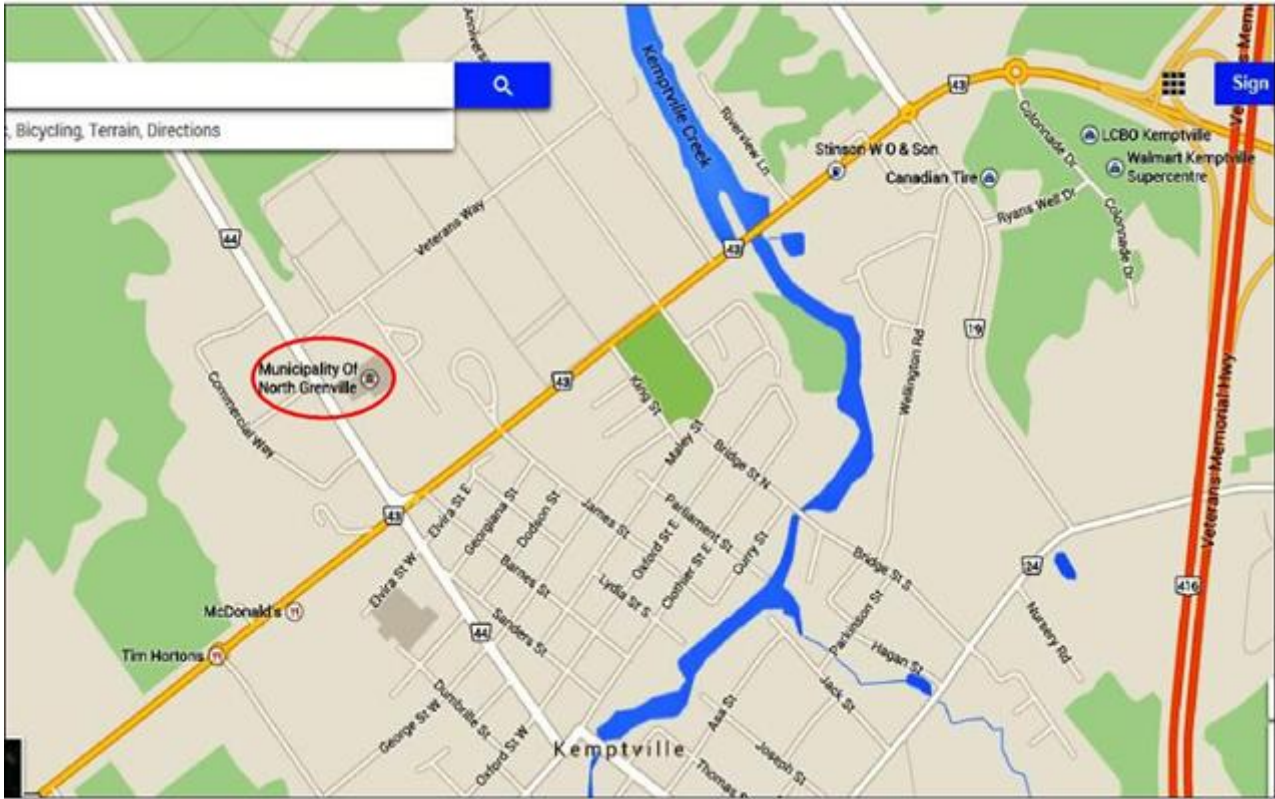
- ***Three Decades of the Woodlot Conference and Counting*** – Brian Barkley, Landowner/ Founding Eastern Ontario Model Forest member
