#### Leitrim Wetland Restoration



Viewing platform, Leitrim Wetland, Findlay Creek

- 6 dams installed to slow water flows through the wetland
- Buckthorn cleared from end of boardwalk
- 100 native trees planted to outcompete glossy buckthorn

## Findlay Creek Swale



New vegetation along Findlay Creek Swale

- 450 trees and shrubs planted along North-South Swale
- Trees will provide stream shading and natural nutrient inputs to stream into future



#### Shield's Creek Naturalization – Project Completed



Property border planting, Shield's Creek, Greely

- 110 caliper sized trees planted to define property boundary
- 1600+ potted trees and shrubs planted
- 2+ acres of wildflower meadow sowed
- 6 erosion control projects
- 3 fish migration barriers removed
- Fencing installed to limit shoreline disturbances
- 2 cubic yards of boulders added for aquatic habitat
- 12 bird nesting boxes installed
- 30+ volunteers engaged
- Presentation to Greely Community Association



## Chesterville Shoreline Planting

- North Dundas Township controlled wild parsnip on banks of river
- Funding provided to SNC to plant species to outcompete regrowth of wild parsnip





## **OPG Biodiversity**



Sweetflag, *Acorus calamus,* along edge of wetland

- After completion of windthrow creations, native trees, shrubs and plants were planted in the project area;
- Impacts of drought will be assessed in spring of 2019.



## **OPG Biodiversity**



Phragmites australis patch in Larose Forest Biodiversity project site, April 2018.

- Spring of 2019, monitoring of drains and pits for amphibians, plant survival and emergence, and replacing dead plants
- Invasive Alien Species
   management: Phragmites
   and Buckthorn targeted
   herbicide application
