Fred Schueler, Committee Chair, opened the September 4th, 2018 Fish and Wildlife Committee meeting at 3:05 p.m. and welcomed Members.

A roundtable discussion on invasive species occurred with the following highlights:

- Fred Schueler discussed the differences between native and invasive Phragmites and provided specimens for the Committee to view.
- He then discussed dog-strangling vine and its ecological impacts, and Cyril Holmes provided specimens for observation.
- Bill Smirle requested that the Committee consider calling a special meeting to dedicate to learning about invasive species in the region.
- The Committee agreed that education on invasive species is still lacking for the majority of watershed residents.
- Bill Smirle requested that specimens of Phragmites and dog-strangling vine be brought to the September Board of Directors meeting.
- Bruce Clarke provided a series of questions to the Committee regarding his thoughts on SNC's invasive species activities. He then put forward a motion to recommend inclusion of a more robust invasive species program in SNC's draft 2019 Budget.
