## **Supporting Municipal Planning**



Water Quality Sensor Deployment

- Deployment of 2 long-term sensors for water quality information
- Data to be analyzed as part of the South Bear Brook Catchment Study for the City of Ottawa
- Study provides information on current conditions and recommendations for improvement



### **Headwater Drainage Features**



Tributary of South Bear Brook City of Ottawa

- South Bear Brook Catchment Study
- Support Subwatershed Studies and development reviews within the City of Ottawa



### **Western Chorus Frog Habitat Project**



Gauge installed at pond east of Bouvier Road SNC compartment #45, Bourget

- Seasonal pools for endangered Western Chorus Frogs (vernal pools)
- Funded by Environment and Climate Change Canada
- Water level monitoring on hold due to COVID-19 restrictions, all federal contracts affected



### **Velema Property Inventory**

- Vegetation and bird survey of SNC's newest property acquisition
- 37 bird species, 2 Special Concern under the Endangered Species Act
- Vernal pools evident throughout property

### **SNC Grasslands**




Male and Female Bobolink

- Grassland bird monitoring at SNC 97 (Berwick), SNC 114 (Chesterville) and Upper Canada Migratory Bird Sanctuary (Ingleside)
- 62 total bird species between the three properties since 2016
- Bobolink consistently encountered

New flood risk mapping identifies vulnerable properties for municipal emergency response



### Flood Forecasting and Warning Program



#### What We Do

- Provide municipalities with advanced notice of flooding and low water conditions
- Model and predict flood events
- Operate and maintain dams and other water control structures
- Monitor stream flow
  - Track radar information
    - Conduct snow and ice surveys

#### **Lower Ottawa River**

Spring Freshet Ended – water levels are within normal range

#### **South Nation Watershed**

No Statement in effect – water levels are within normal range

#### St. Lawrence River

Flood Watch in effect – Lake Ontario on track to peak well below 2017 and 2019 record highs

### **Revised Spring Free Tree Pick Ups**

- Over 150 households per municipality selected to receive bundles of free tree seedlings
- Coordinated approach with participating municipalities enabled direct delivery in some areas, and curbside pick ups in others



### **Seasonal Conservation Areas Now Open**






Conservation Areas with river access opened beginning

# **New SNC Property in Augusta**

- \$31,500 in Federal funding received to create a Conservation Area
- First SNC property in Augusta, access to South Nation River
- 9.1 acres transferred from Augusta Township to SNC
