


2019 Municipal Information Day SNC's Administrative Office

 - 2023: \$50,000






Electrofishing Shield's Creek Greely

- Municipalities can require builders to create educational guides for new homeowners. SNC often reviews these guides on their behalf.
- SNC has created a new draft guidebook that can now be used by developers and will be made available online.






Customer Service and Section 28 Permit Application

- Time tracking on permit applications
 - Annual report to Conservation
 Ontario on timelines
 - Improvements to tracking software and client services; more accurate information for 2021





Official Plan Schedule used to direct development

Conservation Authorities are providing input on the City's new Official Plan

Priorities:

- protect public
- streamline process

Outcomes:

- floodplains included
- Improved process for routine updates





- Floodplain Standards Sub-Group National Standarization of floodplain mapping guidelines and best practices. Hosted by Standards Council of Canada, Natural Resources Canada and Public Safety Canada.
- Natural Hazards Technical Guides Sub-Committee -Update the provincial floodplain guidelines (2002).
 Hosted by Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry.




Protecting People and Property: Spring Freshet
