

Budget Schedule – General Notes

Salaries and Employee Benefits

- Example: a \$76,000 salary will cost approximately \$96,000 including payroll premiums, group benefits and Retirement Savings Plan contributions
- Cost of Living (effective July) Estimate 0.5%, minimal budget impact
- Increase per personnel policy Average of upper tier municipal partners
- 42.7 FTE's 2021 budget vs 44.5 FTE's 2020 forecast

Travel and Training

- Travel: includes transportation costs for site visits, customer visits, and external meetings
- Training: includes mandatory training (First Aid/Health and Safety etc.); technical (maintain expert levels); and virtual conferences (partner and peer networking)






