Subject: Update: Estimated Statement of Operations for May 31st, 2023

RECOMMENDATION:

The Board of Directors receive and file the Estimated Statement of Operations for the year ending December 31st, 2023, as of May 31st, 2023, update.

DISCUSSION:

The Net Overall amount represents total expenditures, operating, capital, and project, minus total revenue. The operational budget is the day-to-day expenses the Authority requires for normal activities. Expenses for projects are normally for a fixed term period. Capital expenditures are as per SNC's *Tangible Capital Assets Policy* revised in August 2021. "Tangible" capital assets are goods that have a life expectancy of more than one (1) year, and costs normally over \$5,000, with some exceptions. This Policy can be reviewed at any time, if necessary.

Currently, Senior Management, Team, and Project Leads are estimating a surplus of \$130,000. A full review of 2023 revenues and expenditures will continue through to the end of 2023.

The final 2023 reserve transfer will be presented to the Board along with the audited financial statements at the March 2024 board meeting.

Subject: Request for Approval: 2 Billion Tree Contribution Agreement

RECOMMENDATION:

The Board of Directors approve entering into a 5-year contribution agreement with Natural Resources Canada for approximately \$550,000 funding under the 2 Billion Tree Program.

DISCUSSION:

In December 2022, the Board of Directors approved a submission to the 2 Billion Tree Program (BD-216/22) to support recovery from the May 2022 derecho storm event that devastated forests in eastern Ontario. Funding is administered by Natural Resources Canada (NRCan).

NRCan approved the project on June 12th, 2023, subject to SNC entering into a contribution agreement with Canada. The contribution agreement provides for \$550,000 over five years in Federal support for restoration of affected forests. Funding requires a 50% matching contribution.

Staff will work with partners that have similar funding available to support storm recovery and landowners participating in the program will be required to provide a contribution towards reforestation efforts.

Staff are seeking approval to finalize and execute the contribution agreement, which will enable landowner contact and drafting of detailed workplans. Further expenditures for the project will be brought to the Board for approval as required.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS/ADHERENCE TO SNC POLICY:

<u>Compliance with Budget</u>: Not included in the 2023 SNC Budget; 50% required matching funds will be provided by SNC, partners, and participating landowners.

<u>SNC Policy Adherence</u>: Adheres to SNC Administrative By-Laws s.8 (d) Powers of the Board of Directors - designating and empowering signing officers to sign contracts, agreements, and other documents on behalf of the Authority. Project expenses will adhere to SNC's Purchasing Policy.
