Subject: Risk Management Official and Inspector Appointment

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

The South Nation Source Protection Authority appoint Alison McDonald as Risk Management Official and Risk Management Inspector pursuant to subsection 48 (2) of the *Clean Water Act*, 2006.

#### **Discussion:**

The Raisin-South Nation Source Protection Plan contains policies that regulate significant drinking water threats under Part IV of the *Clean Water Act* (the "Act"). Municipalities are responsible for regulating drinking water threats under this section of the Act but may delegate this responsibility to a Source Protection Authority via agreement. Thirteen municipalities delegate the regulation of drinking water threats under Part IV of the Act to South Nation Conservation (SNC), acting as a Source Protection Authority.

To fulfil its regulatory role, SNC appoints Risk Management Officials (RMO) and Risk Management Inspectors (RMI) pursuant to subsection 48 (2) of the *Clean Water Act, 2006* to administer and enforce Part IV policies. SNC currently has two staff appointed as RMO and three appointed as RMI.

Staff recommend appointing Alison McDonald as RMO / RMI to support risk management responsibilities, when required. Ms. McDonald has successfully completed the Ministry of Environment Conservation and Parks RMO / RMI training course and is qualified to carry out these duties.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

The South Nation Source Protection Authority officially appoint Robert Rathbun as the City of Cornwall municipal representative on the Raisin-South Nation Source Protection Committee.

# Background:

As outlined in the *Clean Water Act, 2006*, under Ontario Regulation 288/07, the Raisin-South Source Protection Committee was created to develop a Source Protection Plan to protect municipal sources of drinking water in the region. The Committee oversees the source protection program, and the composition ensures that a variety of local interests are represented at the decision-making table.

The Raisin-South Nation Source Protection Committee is comprised of 15 members, 4 liaisons and the Chair. Membership consists of:

- Municipal representatives (5)
- Economic sector representatives (5)
  - o 3 members representing the agricultural sector
  - 1 member for the aggregate sector
  - 1 member for the industrial/commercial sector
- Other interest representatives (5)
  - 1 member representing the SNC Clean Water Committee
  - 1 member representing the Great River Network
  - o 3 members representing the general public
