Fall Survival Assessments



- Tree planting sites under the 50 Million Tree Program
- Assessments required in year 2 and 5
- 81 sites visited
 - Year 2:64%
 - Year 5: 59%





Tree Planting Legion Park - Cardinal

Services provided:

- Professional services
- 25 large trees planted
- 175 trees assessed
 - 60 trees require pruning
 - 15 removals

 - Managing the retention of a consultant to prepare a risk assessment and propose solutions




Debris removal: Chesterville Dam

- SNC's first full-service washroom






New Bear Brook stream gauge, City of Clarence Rockland

- New real-time water level and flow gauge installed in Bear Brook on the City of Ottawa/ UCPR boundary
- Increases understanding of existing conditions
- Contributes to early warning and alerting for flood conditions



South Branch of the South Nation River

- South Branch of the SNR Hazard Mapping is the first partnership between SNC and SDG
- Flood Hazard study is done and under peer review
- Erosion Hazard study is complete
- SDG is looking forward to meeting with SNC to discuss creating floodplain maps for their infrastructure





'Sinkhole' Site Visit in Moose Creek



- On October 26th SNC was contacted about a possible sinkhole at the Moose Creek Recreation Center
- Staff performed a site visit on October 27th
- Based on the analysis, the anomaly did not have features indicative of a sinkhole and did not pose a safety risk
- Recommendation: continue to monitor the area


Proposed Subdivision - Township of North Grenville

- Karst indicator identified by proponent's professional consultant.
- Technical review of the report managed by SNC.
- Findings and recommendation supported by the second reviewer.



Floodplain Mapping

- Over the last 10 years:
 SNC has updated 325 km
 - o In progress: 125 km
 - Old floodplains that require update: 325.2
 - As urban areas extend, other streams will need to be mapped
