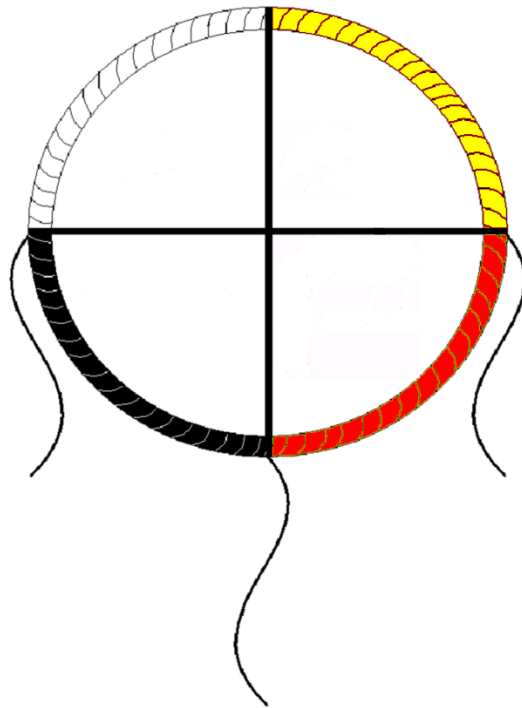




The Three Figure refers to the agreement with the first Europeans and others to work and live in harmony with each other and that the Algonquin people would show them how to survive in this great place the creator has provided
